

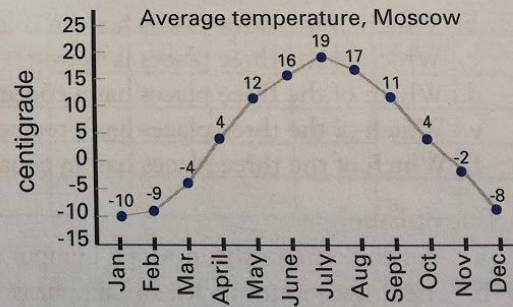
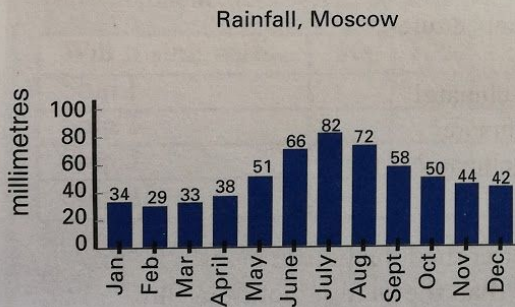
Humidity

If you have ever walked into a warm room where clothes are drying you will have noticed that the air is damp. When the weather is hot and there is a lot of moisture in the air, we say that the weather is humid. Places such as Kuala Lumpur are humid. There is plenty of rain and the temperatures are very hot. Living in a humid climate is very uncomfortable and many buildings have air conditioning.



The above graphs show the average amount of rainfall and the average temperature each month in the city of Kuala Lumpur which is just 3° north of the equator.
