ENGLISH

Sight words It is important to remember that these words cannot be decoded i.e. your child **SHOULD NOT BREAK THE WORDS DOWN** sound by sound like they have been doing with the words in their readers up until now. The word is learned as a whole. If you have any questions, please get in touch 😊

Your child should listen to the "I" story and listen to and learn the "I" song, included on this weeks table of work.

When reading, encourage your child to follow the words with their finger. If they are stuck give them the **sound** rather than the **name** of the letter. Instruct your child "are there any clues in the picture to help you?"

Writing "I" letter of the week, please see video on Seesaw if required, for proper formation and terms.

MATHS

Please find "number hint sheet" on Seesaw when forming the numbers.

The children understand that a high standard of tracing is expected, if their pencil mark comes off the line, draw their attention to it and ask "is this your best work?". This passes the responsibility to the child and will encourage them to do better on the next number.

Always try to incorporate the language from the lesson into every day life, making the learning more real for the children.
